Manufacturing Capacity: 120 million bricks per year – enough for 8,300 all brick houses – the largest brick manufacturing facility in the U.S.

Plant Size: 295,000 square feet

Cost: Approximately \$58 million

Full-Time Employees: 50

Energy Source: Methane Gas from Republic Services “Victory” landfill

Other Green / Energy Saving Measures:

- Zero waste facility all materials used in manufacturing process are recycled
- Lights in plant on sensors and timers for minimal use
- Premium efficiency motors used in all plant machines
- Raw materials sourced from reclaimed coal mine only ¼ mile from plant
